

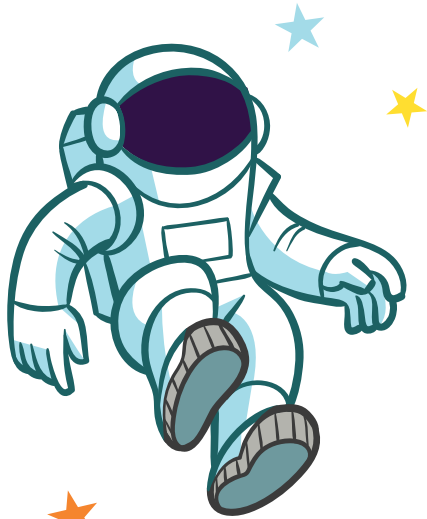

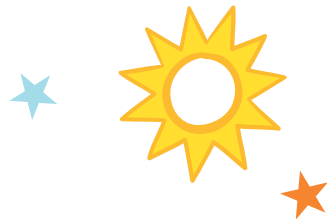


Bath Time

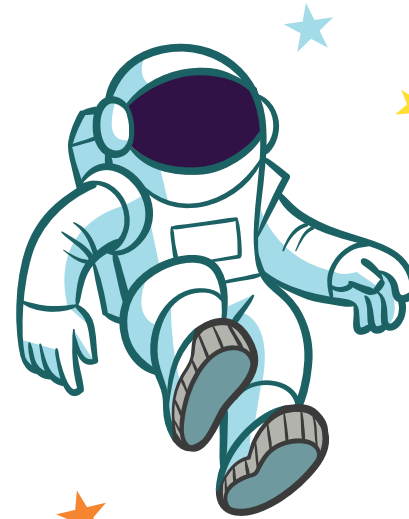

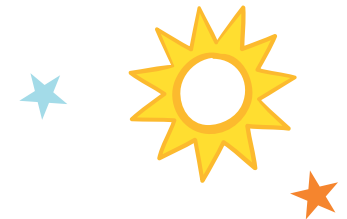


Bath Time
